MEDICARE PART C/D OPEN ENROLLMENT

Every year from October 15th through December 7th, this is the time for Medicare beneficiaries to review Medicare Advantage plans and/or Medicare Prescription Drug plans for the 2022 year.

SOCIAL SECURITY EXPANDS COMPASSIONATE ALLOWANCE PROGRAM

Social Security Administration (SSA) has added 12 new Compassionate Allowances conditions. The program quickly identifies severe medical conditions and diseases that meet Social Security's standards for disability benefits.

SECRETARY OF STATE UPDATE

Beginning the week of September 7th, the Schaumburg Secretary of State location will require appointments to apply or renew driver's licenses and ID cards due to the long lines they are experiencing.

Visit www.cyberdriverillinois.com or call the appointment helpline at 844-817-4649 to schedule an appointment. Even though appointments will be required, older adults, people with disabilities, and those who are pregnant will still be allowed to walk-in.

LIHEAP/PIPP

CEDA's Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) is designed to assist eligible low-income households to pay for winter energy services. LIHEAP provides a one-time benefit to eligible households to be used for energy bills (i.e. ComEd and Nicor). Program begins September 1.

LIHEAP includes the Percentage of Income Payment Plan (PIPP) which will also be available starting September 1, for LIHEAP eligible households. Under PIPP, eligible households pay a percentage of their income towards their utility bill, supplemented by a monthly benefit. Participating households are eligible for a reduction in outstanding bills for every on-time payment they make. Applicants will be served on a first-come, first-served basis until funding is exhausted.

Illinois Senate Bill 100 was signed into law that changed Medicaid Spenddown from 3 months to 6 months' timeframe. The Department of Human Services (DHS) cannot cancel the client's case, if Spenddown was not met for that many consecutive months.
