The Adopt-a-Family matching process is in full swing! Donors will be receiving communication regarding their adoptee by the second week of November.



SPEECH IPAD PROVIDED BY ITAC

The Illinois Telecommunications Access Corporation (ITAC) is offering an Apple iPad with Augmentative and Alternative Communication Apps to help individuals with speech disabilities communicate.

The Apple iPad and the communication apps loaded onto the iPad are part of a loan program.

To qualify for the iPad with AAC apps, certification of the applicant's speech disability from a speech language pathologist is required on the application. Applications are available in the Disability Services Department or by calling ITAC at 1-800-841-6167.

APPLY FOR PASSPORTS EARLY TO TRAVEL INTERNATIONALLY

Did you know the Township of Schaumburg is a passport acceptance agency? We can help with new and renewal passports for people of all ages! At the time of printing, routine passport processing can take up to 14 weeks with expedited service taking up to 10 weeks. Expedited service is an extra \$60 per application. The Township also takes passport-approved photos for \$10. No appointments are needed. Passport applications are accepted Monday-Friday from 9-4pm. 




MEDICARE ANNUAL ENROLLMENT PERIOD OPEN UNTIL DECEMBER 7

Medicare can be very intimidating and many residents don't know where or how to get started. The Township can help! The annual enrollment period for Medicare Part C ("Advantage") and Part D ("Prescription Drugs") occurs every year from October 15th - December 7th. The Township has several Senior Health Insurance Program (SHIP) counselors who can provide free, unbiased information. SHIP is a program from the Illinois Department on Aging, and is designed to help older adults with their Medicare and other health insurance options. If you would like to meet with a counselor, appointments are required. Please contact 847-285-4541 appointments are limited. We are happy to conduct your appointment over the phone if preferred. You can also call 1-800-MEDICARE or the State of Illinois SHIP Hotline at 800-252-8966 for assistance. We look forward to assisting you with the annual enrollment period, or other Medicare questions.

AARP INCOME TAX ASSISTANCE

AARP Tax Aide helps low- to moderate-income taxpayers file their state and federal returns at no cost. Appointments at the Township will likely be available from early February through April. Individuals are reminded to contact our office after January 24, 2022, to schedule an appointment. Appointments will be scheduled in date order to ensure the most individuals can be assisted. Due to COVID-19, this program is subject to change. Up-to-date information will be available on schaumburgtownship.org, including how to make an appointment as this year the process for scheduling an appointment has changed.

AARP TAX AIDE VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

Each year AARP relies on skilled volunteers to help run this incredibly popular program. This year, AARP needs to fill Local Coordinator and Counselor volunteer positions. Local Coordinators are responsible for implementing program plans for one or more Tax Aide locations and to ensure program compliance with AARP Foundation program policies and IRS Quality Site Requirements. Counselors provide tax assistance and preparation services to taxpayers under the supervision of the Local Coordinator. 
- Avoid close contacts with anyone outside your household.
