#### BENEFIT ACCESS PROGRAM

The Benefit Access program offers a license plate discount and Seniors &

Persons with Disabilities Ride Free Transit cards. You only have to apply once every two years.

If you need to renew or apply (first-time applicants), call for an appointment at 224-520-9763 VP. If you are not sure about your status, please call, so we can check for you.

Eligibility requirements are:

- Age 65 years or older or 16 years or older and permanently disabled before January 1, 2020.
- Must live in Illinois at the time you file your application.
- Incomes: Gross Household 2019 Yearly Income \$33,562 - 1 person household \$44,533 - 2 person household \$55,500 - 3 person household

\* Effective January 1, 2021 applications submitted between January 1, 2021 and May 17, 2021 should use 2019 income to file.

\* Applications submitted on May 18, 2021 or after must use 2020 income to file.

\* If you application was "denied" using your 2019 income, you may re-apply using your 2020 income on or after May 18, 2021.



#### LIHEAP BENEFITS STILL AVAILABLE

The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) assists low-

income households with gas and/or electricity bills. Appointments can be done remotely and in-person if needed. This program will end on May 31, 2021.

Gross Monthly Income Eligibility:

- \$2,127 (1-person household)
- \$2,873 (2-persons household)
- \$3,620 (3-persons household)
- \$4,367 (4-persons household)
