Medicare Part C and D Open Enrollment:

It is important to know the deadline is December 7, 2021 to review, change, join or cancel Part C or Part D plans. Any changes to your plans will be in effect January 1, 2022. Sarita Phadke is a SHIP (Senior Health Insurance Program) Counselor who can assist you with information/assistance with enrollment or solving issues with a current plan. SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFITS

Approximately 7 million Americans will see a 5.9 percent increase in their Social Security benefits and Supplemental Security Income (SSI) in 2022.

Here are some important information:

- SSI \$841 (individual); \$1,261 (couple)
- SSI Resource Limits \$2,000 (individual);
 \$3,000 (couple)
- Substantial Gainful Activity \$1,350/mo. (non-Blind); \$2,260/mo. (Blind)
- Trial Work Period \$970/mo.


