MEDICARE PART C/D OPEN ENROLLMENT



Medicare Part C and D Open Enrollment Period is October 15 – December 7, 2021. It is a good time to review, change, join or cancel Part C or Part D plans. Any changes to your plans will be in effect January 1, 2022. You do not have to change your plan, but it is recommended to check if another plan could be benefit for you. Sarita Phadke is a SHIP (Senior Health Insurance Program) Counselor and she can assist you with information/assistance with enrollment or troubleshooting issues with a current plan. LIHEAP/PIPP AVAILABLE NOW!

NEWS FROM SECRETARY OF STATE

Illinois Secretary of State announced some changes including requiring appointments for driver's licenses and ID cards after continued long lines at the facilities. Starting September 7th week, several suburban facilities including those in Schaumburg, Lombard, Des Plaines, Aurora, Waukegan, Naperville, Plano and Joliet, will require appointments. 
