





FEMA COVID-19 FUNERAL ASSISTANCE

Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) is providing financial assistance for COVID-19 related funeral expenses incurred after January 20, 2020.

Applications are now being accepted only by calling the COVID-19 Funeral Assistance Line at 844-684-6333 Monday—Friday 9 am—9 pm.

PAINT-A-THON

If the exterior of your home or garage needs a fresh coat of paint due to peeling, fading, or worn paint, apply for the Paint-a-Thon program!

This program provides for the painting of the exterior of single family homes at no cost to the homeowners with limited financial resources. Homeowners must be at least 60 years of age, or have a permanent disability, or be a veteran of any age.

HOMEBOUND VACCINATIONS

Are you or someone you know unable to get in a vehicle to get a COVID-19 vaccine? Homebound residents in Cook County can now call the Cook County Vaccine Hotline at 833-308-1988 to be added to the wait list for in in-home vaccination.

Once added to the list, homebound residents will then be contacted by a home health provider for an appointment for an in-home vaccination. The Cook County Vaccine Hotline hours are Monday— Friday 7am—10pm and Saturdays 8am—10pm.

TRIP PROGRAM

In a cooperative effort with PACE, Schaumburg Township has joined Elk Grove, Hanover, Palatine and Wheeling Townships in providing the Township Riders Initiative Program (TRIP) to its residents. The TRIP program allows eligible residents to receive transportation from PACE within the boundaries of Barrington, Elk Grove, Hanover, Maine, Schaumburg, Palatine, and Wheeling Township for medical purposes only.

Rides are available Monday – Friday 5 am—9 pm and Saturday 7 am—4 pm. One-way cost is \$5 per township line crossed during a single trip with a maximum of \$10 per one-way.

Individuals must register for the TRIP program 7 to 10 days before needing their first ride in order to allow time to be approved. To register, please call Schaumburg Township Transportation at 847-882-1929. Once registered, individuals can schedule rides through the TRIP Program by calling Schaumburg Township Transportation Dispatch.
