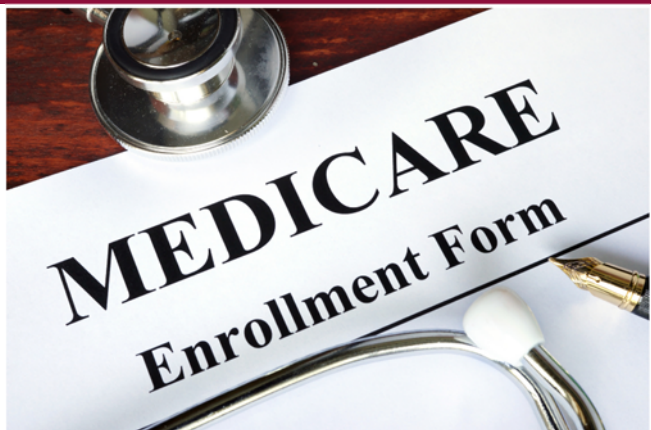

LIHEAP/PIPP

CEDA's Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) is designed to assist eligible low-income households to pay for winter energy services. LIHEAP will provide a one-time benefit to eligible households to be used for energy bills (i.e. ComEd and Nicor). Program begins September 1.

LIHEAP includes the Percentage of Income Payment Plan (PIPP) which will also be available starting September 1, for LIHEAP eligible households. Under PIPP, eligible households pay a percentage of their income towards their utility bill, supplemented by a monthly benefit. Participating households are eligible for a reduction in outstanding bills for every on-time payment they make. Applicants will be served on a first-come, first-served basis until funding is exhausted.
