# Winter is around the corner. Here are some safety tips:

#### Medicare Part C and D Open Enrollment

It is important to know that the deadline is December 7 to review, change, join or cancel Part C or D plans. Any changes to your plans will be in effect January 1, 2023. # 2023 SOCIAL SECURITY/MEDICARE BENEFITS

Social Security and Supplemental Security Income (SSI) beneficiaries will receive an 8.7% COLA (Cost-of-Living Adjustments) for 2023.

- SSI \$914 (individual); \$1,371 (couple)
- SSI Resource Limits \$2,000 (individual);
  \$3,000 (couple)
- Substantial Gainful Activity \$,1,470 (nonblind); \$2,460 (blind)
- Trial Period \$1,050

**Other Information:** Another good news is that Medicare premiums are going down.

- Medicare Part B Monthly Premium -\$164.90
- Annual Deductible (Part B) -\$226
