

Schaumburg Township Senior Citizens Services Committee Meeting Minutes

November 15, 2022

- I. Call to Order Chairperson Croke called the meeting to order at 7pm.

- III. Approval of October 18, 2022 Minutes Motion to approve the minutes from the October 18, 2022 SCSC meeting was made by Linda Kasinger. Seconded by Marilyn Pande. Motion carried.

- V. Reports
 - a. Chairperson's Report Chairperson Croke stated she attended the presentation on using the Medicare Plan Finder and Medicare Part D by Senior Services. She was very impressed by the presentation and found it incredibly helpful and informative. Chairperson Croke also stated she was impressed with the new newsletter, Access Point.
 - b. Trustee Liaison's Report

Trustee Steward seconded Chairperson Croke's feedback regarding the new newsletter format. He reported the Board will be discussing the levy at this month's Board meeting. Budget planning for FY24 has begun and discussions about the budget will continue in the coming months. The referendum for a 708 Mental Health Board passed in the November general election. At the Special Town Meeting in November, the electors approved the Township to enroll in the IMRF pension plan. This will provide employees with a stable pension and also save the Township approximately \$1million over the next 10 years.

c. Director's Report

Director Cordes reported applications for the Holiday Adoption program have been collected from over 130 seniors. Director Cordes is working with the Community Relations Coordinator to recruit more donors through Facebook as donors are needed for approximately 20 more seniors. Medicare Open Enrollment continues and is going well. Staff calendars are filling up quickly, but staff are offering a limited number of evening appointments to help more residents.
