Calling all Medicare beneficiaries! It’s that time of the year again to review your Medicare Prescription Drug Plans (Part D) and Medicare Advantage Plans (Part C). The Annual Medicare Open Enrollment Period runs from October 15–December 7. During this timeframe, Medicare beneficiaries can decide to review and make changes to their current Medicare coverage for next year. This is the opportunity for you to make sure that your plan continues to be the best one for you. Disability & Senior Services Staff are certified Senior Health Insurance Program (SHIP) Counselors that can provide unbiased Medicare counseling and assist with enrollment. PROPERTY AFTER DEATH



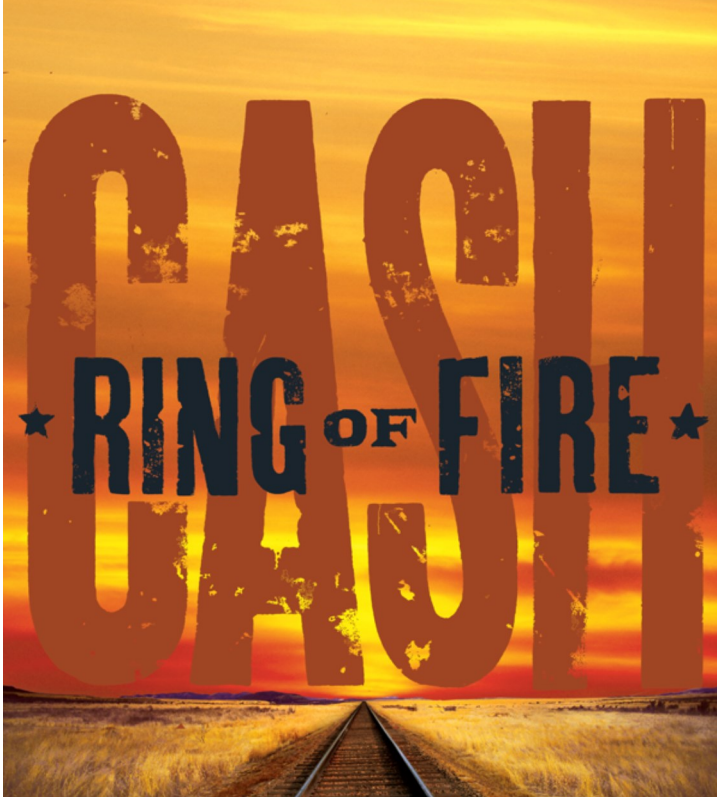

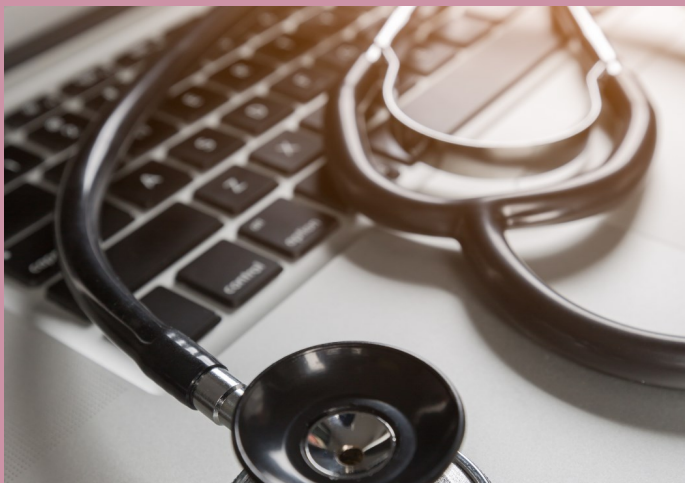

TRANSPORTATION

Schaumburg Township transportation services are provided for seniors (age 55+) and people with permanent disabilities (age 18+) who reside within Schaumburg Township. All riders must register with the Transportation Department prior to service. Verification of age and residency is required. Permanently Disabled Citizens must furnish proof of permanent disability. Reservations are required and are taken on a first come-first serve basis. All reservations must be made no less than 72 hours in advance before 3pm, Monday – Friday. Appointments must be confirmed for reservations to be accepted. If an assistant is required, a seat must be reserved for them when the reservation is made. Call Transportation at 847-882-1929 to make reservations.

SOCIAL SERVICES

LOW INCOME HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (LIHEAP)

The LIHEAP program helps eligible low-income households with their heating and electric bills. This program year runs October 2–August 15, 2024. Priority for enrollment is as follows:

- **October:** Seniors age 60+, Individuals with Disabilities, Families with children aged 6 and younger.
- **November:** Households with imminent disconnect notices.
- **December:** Program opens to all qualified households.

To qualify for LIHEAP, households must have income at or below 200% the Federal Poverty Level.

1-person household: \$2,430/30 day; \$29,160/year

2-person household: \$3,287/30 day; \$39,440/year

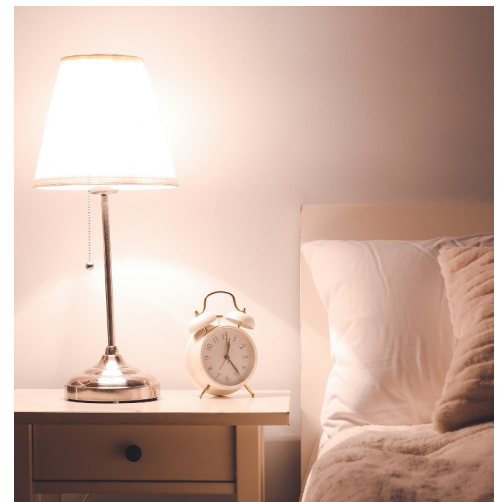
3-person household: \$4,143/30 day; \$49,720/year

4-person household: \$5,000/30 day; \$60,000/year

To apply for the program, you must provide the following documents:

- Social Security cards for everyone in the household
- Proof of 30-day income for everyone in the household
- Most recent gas and electric bills

BENEFIT ACCESS PROGRAM

The Illinois Department of Aging offers a Benefit Access program for income-eligible seniors age 65+ and individuals age 16+ with a permanent disability. Approved individuals will receive a license plate sticker discount and an RTA Ride Free Pass. Both benefits are good for two years.

To qualify, applicants must meet the following income criteria:

- \$33,562 or less for a 1-person household
- \$44,533 or less for a 2-person household
- \$55,500 or less for a 3-person household
