
THANKSGIVING CELEBRATION

Medicare Part C and D Open Enrollment

It is important to know that the deadline is December 7 to review, change, join, or cancel Part C or D plans. Any changes to your place will be in effect January 1, 2024. If you need assistance, please contact Sarita: 224-520-9763 for an appointment or more questions.

Benefits Access Program

It is not too late to apply for Benefits Access Program (Seniors & Persons with Disabilities Free Ride, Free Transits and License Plate Discount). The deadline is December 31, 2023. For more information about the program/ requirements or an appointment to apply/ renew, please call 224-520-9763.

LIHEAP PROGRAM

The Low Income Home Energy Assistance
Program (LIHEAP) helps eligible low-income
households pay for home energy services.
As of now, households with a senior (60+),
persons with a disability and families with
children under 6 can apply for benefits.
Beginning November 1, households
disconnected from one or both utilities can
apply. Beginning December 1, all other Cook
County residents can apply for benefits.

2024 SOCIAL SECURITY/MEDICARE BENEFITS

More than 71 million Americans will see a 3.2% increase in their Social Security benefits and Supplemental Security Income (SSI) payments in 2024.

- * SSI \$943 (individual); \$1,415 (couple)
- * SSI Resource Limits \$2,000 (individual); \$3,000 (couple)
- * Substantial Gainful Activity \$,1,550 (non-blind); \$2,590 (blind)

- * Medicare Part B Monthly Premium \$174.70
- * Annual Deductible (Part B) -\$240
