

#### **DEAF TAX DAY**

This year's Deaf Tax Day will be Wednesday, March 20. Limited appointments will be available at 9am, 10am, 11am and noon. Taxpayers must have all their tax documents ready before scheduling an appointment. ASL interpreters will be provided. Individuals who have purchased or sold digital currency, have business returns, depreciation, and income from rental properties or S corporations are not eligible for AARP Tax-Aide assistance. Taxpayers with appointments scheduled will need to pick up an envelope of information and forms to be completed before their appointment from Disability & Senior Services. Each year, the Township partners with the AARP Foundation to provide FREE income tax assistance. AARP Tax-Aide seeks to assist low-to-moderate -income taxpayers file their state and federal returns at no cost. Please contact Sarita to get a list of required documents, for more questions or an appointment.

## **SOCIAL SERVICES**

#### **EXTRA HELP**

Extra Help is a program that covers Medicare drug coverage (Part D) costs for people with limited income and resources. If you qualify, you will pay \$0 for your Medicare drug plan premium and deductible. Also, you will have a reduced amount of both generic and brand-name drugs. To qualify, your annual income must be below \$21,870 (individual) or \$29,580 (married couple), and your assets must be below \$16,600 (individual) or \$33,240 (married couple). #### BENEFIT ACCESS PROGRAM

The Benefit Access Program (BAP) offers a license plate discount and Seniors and Persons with Disabilities Ride Free Transit Cards. Eligibility Requirements:

- \* Age 65 years or older or 16 years or older and permanently disabled before January 1.
- \* Must live in Illinois at the time you file your application.
- \* Income: \$33,562 (1 person); \$44,533 (2 persons); \$55,500 (3 persons)

If you apply before April 18, you should bring your 2022 income to file. Applications submitted on April 19 or after must use 2023 income to file. If your application was denied using 2022 income, you may re-apply with your 2023 income on or after April 19, 2024. FYI: Those who qualify for BAP will only pay \$10 for their sticker. Only one discount per household per year is allowed. If you need to renew or apply (first-time applicants), call for an appointment: 224-520- 9763.
