COMMUNITY PAPER SHRED AND SMALL ELECTRONICS RECYCLING EVENT JUNE 1

In partnership with the Cook County Sheriff's Office, join us for a free Paper Shred and Small Electronics Recycling event for Township residents on June 1 from 9 -11 am or until the trucks are full at One Illinois Blvd, Hoffman Estates. Paper shredding is limited to four boxes or paper bags per person (1 cubic ft. or 15" x 12" x 10"). No plastic bags please. Boxes must be unsealed. Paper clips, binder clips and rubber bands must be removed. A list of the small electronic items accepted can be found on our website. We ask that participants enter our parking lot heading southbound on Illinois Blvd. so as not to block traffic on Schaumburg Road. Residents do not need to exit their vehicles to participate. In 2023, the pantry experienced its highest number of visits in the last 10 years – over 13,000 visits. This was a 35% increase over 2022. Any donation, big or small, can make a difference. Thank you for your support!

SOCIAL SERVICES



LOW INCOME HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (LIHEAP)

The LIHEAP program helps eligible low-income households with their gas and electric bills. This program year started on October 2, 2023, and is expected to run until August 15, 2024, or until funds are exhausted. To qualify for LIHEAP, the household's 30-day gross income must be at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level:

\$2,430	1-person household
\$3,287	2-person household
\$4,143	3-person household
\$5,000	4-person household
\$5,857	5-person household

The following documents are required to apply for LIHEAP:

- Social Security cards for everyone in the household
- Proof of 30-day gross income for everyone in the household
- Most recent gas and electric bills

MEDICARE SAVINGS PROGRAM

Do you have Medicare? Medicare Savings Programs (MSP) are state programs that can help Medicare beneficiaries with limited income and assets pay for Medicare premiums, deductibles and/or cost sharing through Medicaid. Disability and Senior Services staff are certified SHIP Counselors that can assist with the application process. For more information, or to schedule an appointment, please call 847-285-4541.



BENEFIT ACCESS PROGRAM

The Illinois Department on Aging offers a Benefit Access program for income-eligible seniors age 65+ and individuals age 16+ with a permanent disability. Individuals who are approved will receive a license plate sticker discount and an RTA Ride Free Pass. Both benefits are good for two years. To qualify, applicants must meet the following income criteria:

- \$33,562 or less for a single person
- \$44,533 or less for a couple

If you think you may qualify for Benefit Access and need assistance with the application, please contact Disability & Senior Services at 847-285-4541 to schedule an appointment. PAINT-A-THON APPLICATIONS DUE JULY 1

Do you own your home and does the exterior need to be painted? You might qualify to get your home painted for FREE as part of the 37th Annual Community Paint-A-Thon. To qualify, homes must be owned and occupied by seniors aged 60 and older, people with disabilities, and/or veterans of any age. Owners must be financially disadvantaged or physically unable to paint the exterior of their homes. Homes must be owner-occupied and in sufficient condition so that scraping and spot priming are the only preparations needed. Applications are due by July 1 for painting on September 7.
