




FREE NOTARY SERVICE AT THE TOWNSHIP

MEMORY SCREENING

Every Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday
By appointment | FREE

According to the CDC*, "1 in 10 US adults 45 years and older reported worsening memory loss." As we age, sometimes it is hard to know if forgetting your keys is a harmless sign of aging, or something larger like dementia or Alzheimer's disease. If you aren't sure if your memory is a problem you should be concerned about, consider a free memory screening from Nurse Janet Stachula, RN!

The appointment starts with a discussion about you and why you'd like a screening. Then Nurse Stachula will administer the Brief Alzheimer Screen (BAS) and the General Practitioner Assessment of Cognition (GPCOG), which takes about 15 minutes. The results are available immediately. The screening concludes with a review of the results and information about keeping your mind active. If you don't pass the screening, it is encouraged that you follow up with your doctor. You take your screening results with you.

Taking advantage of this free resource will help you determine if your forgetfulness is innocent or if something more nefarious is at play. If there is a larger issue, having all the facts will help plan for the future and could reduce anxiety about the unknown. Reach out to Nurse Stachula today at 847-285-4551 to learn more.

FREE RABIES VACCINE AND MICROCHIP CLINIC SEPTEMBER 14

In partnership with Cook County Department of Animal and Rabies Control, the Township is proud to host a free rabies vaccine and microchip clinic on September 14 from 10-1pm or until vaccines run out at One Illinois Blvd, Hoffman Estates.

Owners must be Cook County residents and present a valid driver's license or state ID. Pets must be at least three months old and will be seen on a first-come-first-served basis. Owners will be given a vaccine certificate and can order a rabies tag post event here: cookcountyil.gov/service/rabies-vaccination-tags. SOCIAL SERVICES

MEDICARE ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS

Disability and Senior Services staff can assist with several Medicare assistance programs, including Medicare Savings Programs, Extra Help and Medicaid. Eligibility for these programs is determined by gross income and assets. Please call 847-285-4541 to schedule an appointment.

- <u>Medicare Savings Programs (MSP)</u> are state programs that help Medicare beneficiaries with limited incomes and assets pay for Medicare Part A and B premiums and/or cost sharing amounts. You may qualify for a MSP if you are a single person with a monthly income below \$1,717 and assets below \$9,430 or if you are a married couple with a monthly income below \$2,323 and assets below \$14,130
- Extra Help is a program to help Medicare beneficiaries with limited income and resources pay Part D premiums, deductibles, coinsurance and other costs. To qualify for Extra Help, your income must be limited to \$1,902.50/month for an individual or \$2,575/month for a married couple. Also, your assets must be limited to \$17,220 for an individual or \$34,360 for a married couple.
- <u>Medicaid</u> is a program that helps cover medical expenses for some people with limited income and resources. If you are on Medicare, to qualify for Medicaid your income must be below \$1,280/month and assets below \$17,500 for a single person. For a couple, your income must be below \$1,728/month and assets below \$17,500.

FRAUD PREVENTION

Financial scams targeting the elderly are on the rise, including IRS scams, grandparents scams, spoofing scams, tech support scams, solicitor scams, investment scams and romance scams. It is important to understand and identify the signs of a scam and what to do to avoid it.

- Never provide financial or personal information over the phone.
- Keep in mind that government agencies like the IRS will not contact you via email, social media or text.
- If a potential scammer is claiming to be a family member, hang up and check in with your relatives to verify if the information is true.
- Do not click on suspicious links or attachments in emails or text messages. Delete them right away!
- Never wire money to someone that you have never met.
- Only scammers get paid with gift cards or crypto-currency. If you are a victim of fraud, contact your local police department or the Senior Citizens Consumer Fraud Helpline at 1-800-243-5377.

HEARING SERVICES AT SCHAUMBURG
TOWNSHIP WITH ABHF

The Americans for Better Hearing Foundation (ABHF) will be at the Township every 1st Wednesday of the month to administer low-cost hearing services. ABHF is the largest provider of comprehensive hearing services to the Medicare/Medicaid and underinsured/uninsured population in Illinois. ABHF accepts ALL insurance, including Medicare and Medicaid. They also accept clients with no insurance and offer a Fair Pricing Program to help those who self-pay. Services include:

- Hearing Test
- Hearing Aid Fittings
- Hearing Aid Repairs
- Wax Removal
- Hearing Aid Batteries

Appointments are required, with a physician medical referral. Contact the Township to begin the paperwork process at 847-285-4541.



TEST FREE HEARING EQUIPMENT WITH ITAC AT SCHAUMBURG TOWNSHIP

The Illinois Telecommunications Access
Corporation (ITAC) free amplified phone
program provides free phone equipment to
qualified Illinois residents with a certified hearing
loss. Qualified residents may come to the
Township to do a live test call on each of the
phone options and select the phone with the
optimal hearing results for them. Each phone has
varying levels of amplification and adjustments
for tone and clarity. The amplified phones range
from 40 to 55 decibels. There are no age or
income requirements. Residents need to have
landline and/or cell phone service, proof of IL
residency and the application signed by a
medical professional. Applications found on our

- The person with the disability must reside in the Village of Schaumburg or the Township of Schaumburg.
- All persons with disabilities must have an ablebodied adult to accompany them on the rides.
 No exceptions.
- NOT ALL RIDES WILL BE OPEN! The carnival operator is a separate entity and has sole discretion on which rides will be open.

The event is weather-dependent and may be cancelled or delayed. The event will not be rescheduled if cancelled. Free Rides is hosted by the Village of Schaumburg, sponsored by Fantasy Amusement Company, Inc. and coordinated by the Township of Schaumburg.
