

Utility bills weighing you down?

There are a number of programs offering assistance for utilities. Contact Township staff to help determine eligibility and apply if applicable. Household with an individual 55+ or a person with a disability, call the Disability & Senior Services Department at 847-285-4541, and all other residents please call the Welfare Services Department at 847-285-4503.

Low Income Home Energy Assistance
Program (LIHEAP) and Reconnection
Assistance (RA) are available at this time.
LIHEAP allows income-eligible households
the opportunity to receive a one-time
benefit applied directly to your heating
and electric utility, per program year.
Reconnection Assistance provides a
benefit up to \$1,500 to prevent imminent
disconnection or to re-connect your
household's heating services.

DID YOU KNOW?

- Help is available on your heating and/or electric bills, even if you are not behind.
- You can apply if you don't have income.
- Delivered fuel households are eligible for assistance.
- Furnace Assistance is also available for households with an inoperable furnace.

DOCUMENTS NEEDED TO APPLY:

- Proof of current 30-day gross income for all household members. This also includes income for children who receive child support or social security benefits.
- Copy of most recent heating and electric bills.
- Proof of social security numbers or ITINS for all household members. Undocumented individuals are welcome to apply.
- ** Please note, additional documentation may be required.
