DONORS

Make the holiday season a bit brighter by adopting a resident in need. Each donor is provided a wish list of either an individual or a family that includes a senior or person with a disability. Donors will be provided wish lists by Friday, November 15. Donation drop off day is Monday, December 9.

RECIPIENTS

Applications from individuals and families to receive donations will be accepted September 3 - October 31. This program is open to seniors aged 55+ and individuals with disabilities who are in need. For families to be eligible, they must include an individual with a disability or grandparent(s) who has custody of grandchildren under the age of 18. Applications must be completed by appointment with a Disability & Senior Services (DSS) staff member either in-person or over the phone. Applicants will be notified if they are matched with a donor. DSS staff does everything possible to match every household with a donor, however, filling out an application does not guarantee adoption. Gift pick-up day is Tuesday, December 10.

FREE BLOOD PRESSURE SCREENINGS

According to the American Health Association*, “Nearly half of U.S. adults have high blood pressure [and] many don’t even know they have it.” Unmanaged high blood pressure can damage your heart and make you more susceptible to heart attack or stroke. Blood pressure is organized into five categories:

Blood Pressure Category*	Systolic mm Hg (Upper Number)	And/Or	Diastolic mm Hg (Lower Number)
Normal	Below 120	And	Below 80
Elevated	120-129	And	Below 80
High Blood Pressure: Hypertension Stage 1	130-139	Or	80-89
High Blood Pressure: Hypertension Stage 2	140 or Higher	Or	90 or Higher
Hypertensive Crisis	Higher than 180	And/Or	Higher than 120

Nurse Stachula, RN offers free blood pressure screenings every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday by appointment. Clients should consider wearing a short-sleeved top to avoid inaccurate readings. Once the screen is complete, Nurse Stachula, RN will consult you on your reading and offer any suggestions for managing a healthy blood pressure range. Monitoring your blood pressure can quite literally save your life and could be indicators of larger health issues. Don’t miss out on this FREE opportunity to keep tabs on your health!



LOW INCOME HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (LIHEAP)

The LIHEAP program helps eligible low-income households with their gas and electric bills. The program year usually begins in the Fall. To qualify for LIHEAP, the household's 30-day gross income must be at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level:

\$2,510	1-person household
\$3,407	2-person household
\$4,303	3-person household
\$5,200	4-person household
\$6,097	5-person household

The following documents are required to apply for LIHEAP:

- Social Security cards for everyone in the household
- Proof of 30-day gross income for everyone in the household
- Most recent gas and electric bills

MEDICARE OPEN ENROLLMENT: OCTOBER 15 - DECEMBER 7

Calling all Medicare Beneficiaries! It's that time of the year again to review your Medicare Prescription Drug Plans (Part D) and Medicare Advantage Plans (Part C). The Annual Medicare Open Enrollment Period runs from October 15 - December 7. During this timeframe, Medicare beneficiaries can decide to review and make changes to their current Medicare coverage for next year. This is the opportunity for you to make sure that your plan continues to be the best one for you. Disability and Senior Services Staff are certified Senior Health Insurance Program (SHIP) Counselors that can provide unbiased Medicare counseling and assist with enrollment. TOWNSHIP OF SCHAUMBURG MENTAL HEALTH BOARD

Did you know the Township’s new Mental Health Board (MHB) funds services for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities and those with substance use disorders? The MHB focuses on analyzing Township needs, identifying available service providers and providing grant funding to improve access to care for Township residents.
