**BRIDGES TO MEMORY**

Every 3rd Wednesday of the Month | 2pm | FREE

Many people correlate dementia and Alzheimer's

disease with memory loss, but it can change a person's personality and emotions as well. This can make caretaking for a partner or a parent challenging. The National Institute on Aging lists the following signs and symptoms of dementia*:

- Experiencing memory loss, poor judgment, and confusion
- Difficulty speaking, understanding and expressing thoughts, or reading and writing
- Wandering and getting lost in a familiar neighborhood
- Trouble handling money responsibly and paying bills
- Repeating questions
- Using unusual words to refer to familiar objects
- Taking longer to complete normal daily tasks
- Losing interest in normal daily activities or events
- Hallucinating or experiencing delusions or paranoia
- Acting impulsively
- Not caring about other people's feelings
- Losing balance and problems with movement

Partners who become caretakers can struggle taking on that new role. Building a community of people experiencing similar changes can be helpful. Every 3rd Wednesday of the month at 2pm, Community Health Nurse Janet Stachula, RN, hosts Bridges to Memory, a group where care recipient and caregiver can enjoy activities together. The free group gathers to craft, listen to music, reminisce, play games and have group discussions. Contact Nurse Stachula, RN, to register at 847-285-4551 or nurse@schtwn.org with any questions.

TWO FOOD DRIVES APRIL 12 - MAY 10

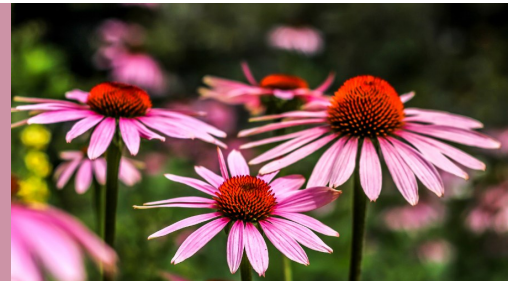

38TH ANNUAL PAINT-A-THON

Does the exterior of your home need to be painted? Consider applying for the 38th Annual Paint-A-Thon program! To qualify, homes must be owned and occupied by older adults aged 60 and older, people with disabilities and veterans of any age. There are income and asset limits, but all are encouraged to apply. Once a home is determined eligible, volunteer groups are matched to do the scraping, priming and painting of the exterior of the home. There is no cost to the homeowner. MEDICARE-MEDICAID ALIGNMENT INITIATIVE (MMAI)

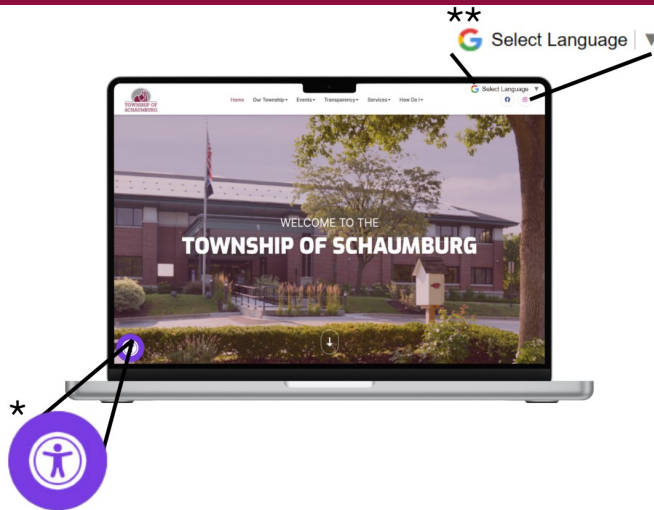
The Medicare-Medicaid Alignment Initiative (MMAI) is a program for seniors and persons with disabilities who have full Medicaid and Medicare benefits. MMAI combines Medicare, Medicaid and prescription drug benefits into one integrated plan and also covers nursing home, dental, vision and transportation services. All MMAI plans include care coordination. Eligible individuals can enroll, switch, or opt out of MMAI plans at any time.

TOWNSHIP WEBSITE ACCESSIBILITY

Did you know schaumburgtownship.org offers an accessibility toolkit? At the bottom left corner of our website you will see a little purple person in a white and purple circle*. When you click on this symbol you will be able to change visual aspects of the website like font type, font size, text spacing and contrast to make it easier to read. Contrast can be set to dark mode, invert colors or greyscale depending on what is best for you. If you need help identifying links, buttons or headings on the website, they can be highlighted for you. Under the focus feature, you can enable the "reading guide," which will put a line under the line you're reading or you can "emphasize" text, which will dim everything but the line you are reading. Other features include turning animations and sounds on/off, hiding images and enabling alternative text for images.

If English is not your preferred language, the Google Translate** feature is in the upper right corner. Please note the Events Calendar and any attached documents will not translate to the selected language. WORLD DOWN SYNDROME DAY




World Down Syndrome Day is on March 21 and is aimed to help people understand and support those with Down Syndrome better. The date, the 21st day of the third month of the year, was symbolically chosen to represent the triplication (trisomy) of the 21st chromosome which causes Down Syndrome. This year's theme calls on governments to improve support systems for individuals with Down Syndrome through laws and policies, social protection, assistive technology, access to affordable transportation and housing, and choice and control over the support they receive.
