JOIN OUR DISABILITY & SENIOR SERVICES COMMITTEE

We are currently seeking individuals with a disability, primary caregivers of individuals with a disability or individuals who have knowledge and experience serving people with disabilities to join our Disability and Senior Services Committee (DSSC). The DSSC is an advisory council to Disability & Senior Services staff and the Township Board of Trustees. Members serve three-year terms and must be residents of Schaumburg Township, aged 18+ and appointed by the Board. DSSC meets the 2nd Tuesday of each month, September - May. PAINT-A-THON APPLICATIONS DUE JULY 1

There is still time to sign up for Paint-A-Thon. Consider applying if the exterior of your house needs painted and your home is owned and occupied by older adults aged 60 and older, people with disabilities and/or veterans of any age. There are income and asset limits, but all are encouraged to apply. Once a home is determined eligible, volunteer groups are matched to do the scraping, priming and painting of the exterior of the home. There is no cost to the homeowner. Current homeowners insurance is required. For more information, or to receive an application, please contact Frances Borja at 847-285-4541.



BENEFIT ACCESS PROGRAM

Benefit Access offers a license plate sticker discount and a RTA Ride Free Pass for income-eligible seniors age 65+ and individuals age 16+ with a permanent disability. Both benefits are good for two years. To qualify, applicants must meet the following income criteria:

- \$33,562 or less for a single person
- \$44,533 or less for a couple

Disability & Senior Services (847-285-4541) can assist with applications via appointment. Applicants should bring your 2024 income tax return and 1099 forms. You can also apply directly on the Illinois Department on Aging's website: <https://ilaging.illinois.gov/benefitsaccess.html>.
