SPECIAL THANKS TO ALL AARP VOLUNTEERS

Thank you to our AARP Tax Aide volunteers who assisted with tax preparations for tax year 2024. It was a success and the residents appreciated the services provided.

This year the free program helped 566 taxpayers get \$495,703 back in federal and state tax returns. We also estimate saving taxpayers about \$170,000 in fees, that would have otherwise been spent on return assistance.

MEDICARE ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS

Disability & Senior Services staff can assist with many social services programs including those below. Please call 847-285-4541 to schedule an appointment.

Medicare Savings Programs (MSP) are state programs that assist Medicare beneficiaries with limited incomes and assets pay for Medicare Part A and B premiums and/or cost sharing amounts. You may qualify for a Medicare Savings Program if you are a single person with a monthly gross income below \$1,784 and assets below \$9,660 or if you are a married couple with a monthly gross income below \$2,403 and assets below \$14,470.

Extra Help is a program that helps low-income Medicare Part D beneficiaries lower their prescription drug costs. It assists with Part D premiums, deductibles, coinsurance, and other costs. To qualify for Extra Help, your gross income must be limited to \$1,976/month for an individual or \$2,663/month for a married couple. Also, your assets must be limited to \$17,600 for an individual or \$35,130 for a married couple.

Medicaid is a program that helps cover medical expenses for people with limited income and resources. If you are on Medicare, to qualify for Medicaid your gross income must be below \$1,304/month and assets below \$17,500 for a single person. For a couple, your gross income must be below \$1,762/month and assets below \$17,500.

Walk-ups on the day of the event will NOT be accepted. This event is limited to the first 500 guests and will fill quickly, so please register early. Please note:

- The person with the disability must reside in the Village of Schaumburg or the Township of Schaumburg.
- All persons with disabilities must have an able-bodied adult to accompany them on the rides. No exceptions.
- NOT ALL RIDES WILL BE OPEN! The carnival operator is a separate entity and has sole discretion on which rides will be open.

The event is weather-dependent and may be cancelled or delayed. The event will not be rescheduled if cancelled. Free Rides is hosted by the Village of Schaumburg, sponsored by Fantasy Amusement Company, Inc. and coordinated by the Township of Schaumburg Disability & Senior Services Department. 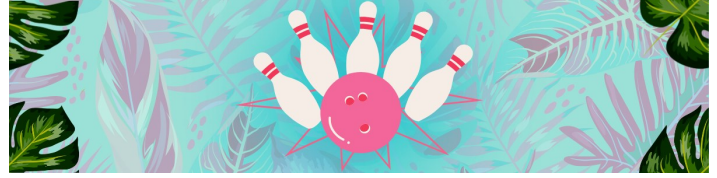
