RECIPIENTS

Applications from individuals and families to receive donations will be accepted September 3 - October 31. This program is open for seniors (55+) and individuals with disabilities who are in need. Families must include an individual with a disability or grandparent(s) who has custody of grandchildren under the age of 18. Applications must be completed by appointment with a Disability & Senior Services (DSS) staff member either in-person or over the phone. Applicants will be notified if they are matched with a donor. DSS staff does everything possible to match every household with a donor, however, filling out an application does not guarantee adoption. Gifts must be picked up Tuesday, December 9.

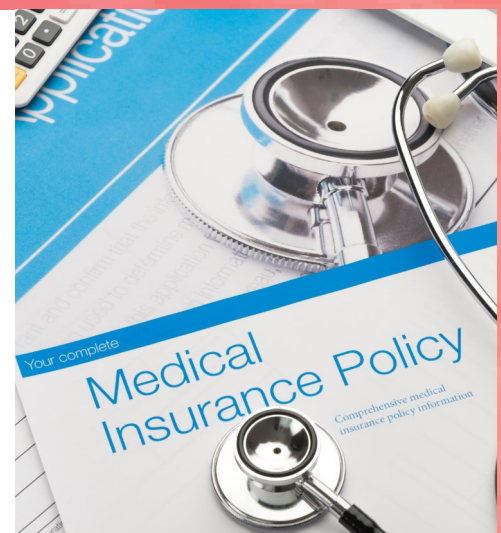

MONTHLY HEALTH AWARENESS RESOURCES

SEPTEMBER: WORLD ALZHEIMER'S MONTH

Forgetfulness or memory lapses can be a normal part of aging, or a sign of a serious problem. Nurse Janet Stachula, RN, provides free memory screenings Tuesday-Thursday by appointment. The screening takes very little time and the results will be reviewed with you at the appointment. Nurse Stachula, RN, will also discuss the differences between normal and age-related forgetfulness, dementia, the 10 warning signs of Alzheimer's disease, when to talk to a doctor, and tips for dealing with forgetfulness. Call 847-285-4551 to make an appointment.

If a loved one has dementia, Alzheimer's disease or diagnosed memory loss, Bridges to Memory might be for you. Each month, Nurse Stachula, RN, curates activities such as reminiscence, arts and crafts, music and more. This support offers a safe environment for care receivers and caretakers to reconnect and socialize. It is also an opportunity for care partners to connect with others in similar situations. First-time registration is requested at 847-285-4551. The group meets every 3rd Wednesday at 2pm.

TOWNSHIP SERVICES

LOW-COST TRANSPORTATION

Township of Schaumburg Transportation Services provides door-to-door rides to older adults (age 55+) and people with disabilities* (age 18+) who reside within the Township. Each bus is wheelchair accessible. All riders are required to register with Transportation Services by completing a registration form found on schaumburgtownship.org. Verification of age and residency is required and persons with disabilities must provide a doctor-signed registration form noting their disability.

Residents can take advantage of Township transportation for medical appointments, errands, shopping, hair appointments and more. Rides are available within the Township, or 7 miles beyond Township boundaries for medical purposes only. Reservations are required and are taken on a "first come-first serve" basis. All reservations must be made a minimum of 72 hours and a maximum of 30 days before a medical appointment. Appointments must be made between 9-4pm on Monday-Friday at 847-882-1929. One-way rides are \$1, two-way rides are \$2 and passes are \$15 for 18 rides.

RABIES VACCINE AND MICROCHIP CLINIC

The Township is proud to host a rabies vaccine and microchip clinic on September 6 from 10-1pm, or until vaccines run out, at 1 Illinois Blvd, Hoffman Estates. Owners must be Cook County residents and present a valid driver's license or state ID. Dogs and cats must be at least three months old and will be seen on a first-come-first-served basis. PROPERTY TAX APPEALS

2025 is a triennial reassessment year, which means each property in the Township will be reassessed by the Cook County Assessor's Office. This fall homeowners can appeal their property taxes for free with the Township Assessor's Office. At the time of printing, final appeal dates have not been released. Final dates will be announced at cookcountyassessor.com under 'Appeal and Deadlines'.

To appeal, email appeals@schaumburgtownship.org your name, home address, property index number (PIN #), phone number and email address. Email is the fastest and most convenient way to file your appeal. While a visit to our office is not required, residents can visit our office Monday-Friday from 8:30-5pm if preferred. You must bring your home address, property index number (PIN #), phone number and email address. All appeal emails must be received at least one hour before closing on the last day of appeals.

Please note any resident who currently has the Senior Freeze Exemption does not have to file a residential appeal as your assessment has been 'frozen' in the year of enrollment. Senior Citizen Exemption recipients can file a residential appeal. Any questions can be directed to the Township of Schaumburg Assessor's Office at 847-285-4567.

SOCIAL SERVICES

MEDICARE OPEN ENROLLMENT: OCTOBER 15-DECEMBER 7

Medicare open enrollment is from October 15-December 7. During this time, you can make changes to your Medicare Advantage (Part C) and Prescription Drug (Part D) plans. This is the opportunity to ensure that your plans continue to meet your needs. Disability & Senior Services staff are certified Senior Health Insurance Program (SHIP) counselors that can provide unbiased Medicare counseling and enrollment assistance. 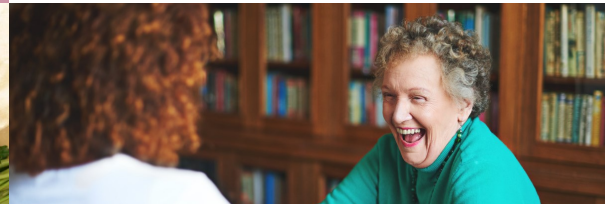
LOW-INCOME HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (LIHEAP)

The LIHEAP program helps eligible low-income households with their heating and electric bills. The income guidelines and requirements have not been released at the time of printing, but the program typically starts in the fall. SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (SNAP) & MEDICAID CUTS

The Township of Schaumburg is closely monitoring recent federal changes to SNAP and Medicaid. There remain unanswered questions regarding the timing and logistics of these changes, but we will continue to be available to assist with applications and redeterminations for both programs. Township staff are here to help the community. If you have questions about SNAP or Medicaid benefits, please call 847-285-4541 to schedule an appointment.



JOIN OUR DISABILITY AND SENIOR SERVICES COMMITTEE

Individuals with a disability, primary caregivers of individuals with a disability or individuals who have knowledge and experience serving people with disabilities can apply to join our Disability and Senior Services Committee (DSSC) for a three-year term. The DSSC is an advisory council to Disability & Senior Services staff and the Township Board of Trustees. Members must be Township residents and at least legal voting age. As an ITAC amplified phone client, you are eligible for renewal of your free amplified phone equipment every three years.
