#### **Department Highlights:**

- Director Nelson spoke with Katlyn Smith from the Daily Herald regarding Hunger Action Month and how the Township is preparing for cuts to SNAP. The article was in the September 7, 2025, edition of the Daily Herald.
- Bilingual Caseworker Barrera had an off-site resource event at the Hoffman Estates Community Resource Center on September 24. The Township answered the call from the village social workers for support from residents experiencing transportation barriers.
- Ten Township staffers completed training to support the PY2026 Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP). This utility assistance program helps low-income households with their utility bills.
- Bilingual Caseworker Barrera collaborated with Digital Communications Coordinator Kasper to
  develop a monthly social media campaign aimed at educating residents about notary services.
   Barrera also worked on website updates for the notary section, providing greater transparency and
  clarity on the free services offered.
- With a 9% increase in food support requests this Hunger Action month the almost 800 volunteer hours were greatly appreciated.
- The team provided pantry support for its first few online orders. Details for the online food pantry ordering are in their final review. This pilot is available to assist clients who face timing and transportation limitations and barriers.

- September 4<sup>th</sup>, Mishelle O'Regan joined the Township Administrative team as Human Resource Coordinator.
   Mishelle has already decorated her office as a cozy, welcoming space for staff. She has dug right in and spent a lot of time training on our Payroll System and other HR services. We welcome her to our team.
- September 6<sup>th</sup>, in assistance with County Board Commissioner Morrisons office, the Township held its annual free Rabies & Microchip clinic in the Road District Building. 130 vaccines were administered from Heartland Veterinary and multiple micro chips were implanted. Thank you to the Road District for their help and use of their building. We were told by staff from Heartland that ours is their favorite location for the clinics.
- On September 26<sup>th</sup>, the Facilities team ran a fire drill. All staff and residents quickly left the building as required, and Directors accounted for their staff per policy. All and all, everything went well and as expected.
- On September 27<sup>th</sup>, the Township held a Saturday Passport Event. The Clerks office, in conjunction with Congressman Raja Krishnamoorthi's office and the Chicago Passport Office, completed over 80 applications and assisted an additional 15-20 with information and requirements in order for them to come back the following week. Along with Director Dionesotes, agents Kate Stewart, Sebasthian Picasso, Frank Concialdi and Sabe Mirza worked with residents from 9am 2pm. Staff left tired, but excited about the work they completed. It was a very impressive day on their part. Thank you also to the Facilities team who helped to set up the area with screen, tables and chairs, then cleaned it all up the following Monday morning before staff arrived at 8:30.
- Construction improvements continued throughout the month on the upper level, Assessors office. Do to stock delay in availability of the carpet, their anticipated date to return to the space is pushed back by a week.





#### **Revenue - Fund Distribution**




#### **Expenditure - Fund Distribution**


