The following documentation is required for your appointment:

- Identification for the head of household (driver's license, state ID, or birth certificate)
- Social Security cards for each household member applying
- Pay stubs for all household members for the previous 30 days
- Income letter showing money received from Social Security, SSI, pension, VA, etc.
- Rent receipt or mortgage statement, property taxes, and/or homeowners' insurance
- Proof of medical expenses for the previous 30 days if 60 years of age or older or receiving Social Security disability
- Medicare card, if applicable
