REFER A FRIEND - GET REWARDED!

If you love our recurring programs and day trips – tell your friends and get rewarded! During January and February 2026, you can earn up to \$50 in free classes or program discounts by referring friends to join in the fun. The program is simple – when a resident registers for/attends their first trip/class and names you as a referral, you both receive the following:

RECURRING PROGRAMS: New attendees get their first class for free. Referring residents receive a voucher for one free class.

DAY TRIPS: New attendees receive a \$10 discount on their first day trip. Referring residents receive a voucher for a \$10 discount on their next day trip.

Please note:

- New attendees must be Schaumburg Township residents who have not attended a DSS program in the last 2 years.
- New attendees are eligible for ONE free class and ONE day trip discount.
- Referring residents are eligible for up to FIVE referral bonuses total for a maximum of \$50 in bonuses.
- Day trip vouchers can be combined.
- Vouchers must be used by December 31, 2026.

CLASS PASS

Love our exercise and wellness classes? Get a Class Pass and save! The Class Pass can be used for any \$5 DSS exercise programs (Fit for Life, Sit & Sweat, Chairobics, Core Fusion, Zumba Gold, Chair Yoga, Tai Chi, Gentle Yoga and Meditation). Class Passes are \$45 and good for 10 classes. That's like purchasing 9 classes and getting 1 for free. Class Passes can be purchased at the DSS reception desk with cash, check or credit card.

FREE PRESCRIPTION DRUG TAKEBACK BOX

The Township partners with the Cook County Sheriff's Office to offer a free Prescription Drug Takeback Box. Drop off your unused and expired prescription and non-prescription drugs in the container on the south side of the Township building (the side facing Schaumburg Road). DIABETES RESOURCES

November is Diabetes Awareness Month and Nurse Janet Stachula, RN, offers support for anyone living with diabetes or prediabetes.

DIABETES SUPPORT GROUP

Each 2nd and 4th Wednesday of the month, from 10:30-11:30am, Nurse Stachula offers a free Diabetes Support Group. The group is comprised of locals who are living with diabetes and prediabetes. Led by Nurse Stachula, participants discuss tips and tricks for managing diabetes and share personal experiences. If you aren't ready to share, you can just come for support. No registration is needed.

A1C TESTING

Nurse Stachula offers A1C testing by appointment, Tuesday-Thursday, for \$12 (cash only). A1C testing measures the amount of glucose (sugar) in your blood. It is used to help diagnose prediabetes/diabetes and to monitor how well you are managing your diabetes. If you don't have a diabetes diagnosis but have other symptoms like extreme thirst, increased urination, blurry vision or feeling tired all the time, you might consider checking your A1C. Additionally, if you have a family history of type 2 diabetes, previously had gestational diabetes, are obese or are sedentary, call Nurse Stachula to see if an A1C would be right for you. Once results are available, Nurse Stachula can refer you to a physician and share additional information for a healthy lifestyle.

FOOD PANTRY DONATIONS NEEDED
TO SUPPORT RECORD GROWTH

The Township Food Pantry continues to see record number of clients. In 2025, the average is over 1,300 families a month. In 2015, the monthly visit average was just under 600 families. While the pantry has great community partners who help supplement donations, the Township is only made possible with donations from the community. Food pantry recipients are about one third older adults, one third children and one third adults.

If you're able to give, we accept donations of non-expired food items, including fresh and frozen goods, Monday-Friday, 8:30-5pm at our North entrance. After 5pm Monday-Thursday, non-perishable donations can be left with the security guard at the main entrance. Please do not leave donations outside any entrance as they attract animals. Paper goods, diapers and hygiene products are also accepted.

VETERAN HONOR ROLL

The Township honors local veterans each month at our Board of Trustees meeting. If you are a veteran or know one that lives in the Township, please review the below eligibility requirements to apply. A veteran must have:

- Served during a time of conflict
- Honorable discharge
- Reside within Schaumburg Township
- A copy of your DD-214 Form
- Completed the Veteran Honor Roll Application

Applications can be found at schaumburgtownship.org or in the Township's Clerk Office. Once honored, veterans are forever featured on our Veteran Honor Wall at the Township and invited to our annual Veteran Honor Roll Dinner each November.

PASSPORT RENEWAL PROCESS MADE EASY

The Township is a U.S. Passport Acceptance Agency. If you have an undamaged passport that has been expired for less than 5 years and you were at least 16 at the time of issuance, you can likely utilize the DS-82 form. The DS-82 can be completed on your own or online, but if you'd like some additional assistance, come to the Township Passport Office! A passport agent can review your application (free), take a passport-approved photo (\$10) and mail it for you (\$10). The passport office is open from 9-4pm on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday and from 9-6pm on Thursdays. Have questions about your application? Call us at 847-285-4561.

SOCIAL SERVICES

LOW INCOME HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (LIHEAP)

The LIHEAP program helps eligible low-income households with their gas and electric bills. To qualify for LIHEAP, the household's 30-day gross income must be at or below the following income guidelines:



\$3,332	1-person household
\$4,357	2-person household
\$5,382	3-person household
\$6,407	4-person household
\$7,432	5-person household

The following documents are required to apply for LIHEAP:

- Social Security cards for everyone in the household
- Proof of 30-day gross income for everyone in the household
- Most recent gas and electric bills

MEDICARE OPEN ENROLLMENT AVAILABLE UNTIL DECEMBER 7

The Annual Medicare Open Enrollment Period runs until December 7. During this time, beneficiaries can review and make changes to their Medicare Prescription Drug plans (Part D) and Medicare Advantage plans (Part C) for next year and make sure you have the best plans for you. DSS Staff are certified Senior Health Insurance Program (SHIP) Counselors that can provide unbiased Medicare counseling and assist with enrollment. ILLINOIS MMAI ENDING IN 2025 – TRANSITION TO FIDE SNPS IN 2026

Illinois' Medicare-Medicaid Alignment Initiative (MMAI) program will end on December 31, 2025. Starting January 1, 2026, the state will launch Fully Integrated Dual Eligible Special Needs Plans (FIDE SNPs) to coordinate Medicare and Medicaid services for dual-eligible beneficiaries. Members in Aetna, Humana, Meridian or Molina MMAI plans will be automatically enrolled in a corresponding FIDE SNP. Members who are currently in Blue Cross Blue Shield MMAI must choose a new plan or will default to Original Medicare and Medicaid with a standalone Part D plan on January 1, 2026.
