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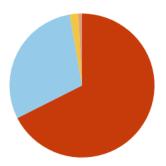

Department Highlights:

- The decrease in utility assistance applications is due to the elimination of energy-efficiency kits. An application is no longer required for these kits, and many of the items previously offered are currently available through the food pantry, thanks to a partnership with ComEd.
- Director Nelson, Associate Director McGinn, and Case Managers Fillmore and Barrera held funding hearings for 10 community partners. The team recommended \$119,000 of funding support for homelessness, housing, domestic violence, foster care, primary health care, and other areas of need for low-income community members.
- Director Nelson and Associate Director McGinn attended the TOI conference in Springfield and accepted the *Outstanding Caseworker of the Year Award for Case Manager Laura Barrera*.
 Ms. Barrera exceeds expectations in her service to residents, the community, and her team. We are honored and proud to work alongside her.
- The food pantry hit a record for most households served in one month, which equated to a 10% increase over last year's numbers. Of the 1,411 households served, 203 were first-time users or had not received pantry assistance in over 6 months. This is an 80% increase in new and returning clients, reflecting the government shutdown and the interruption of SNAP benefits.
- The first whole month of online ordering saw 29 orders. The WS team provided these residents with food, including 19 deliveries, in partnership with the Transportation Department.

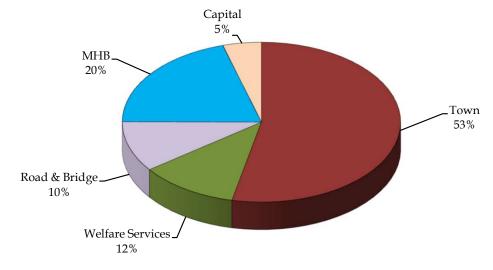

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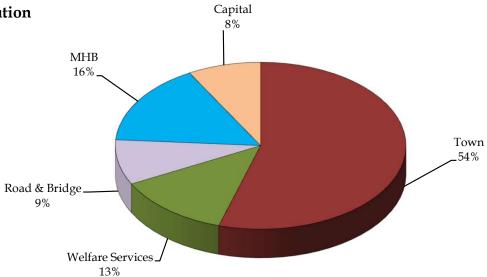
Fund Distribution Graphs

Revenue - Fund Distribution

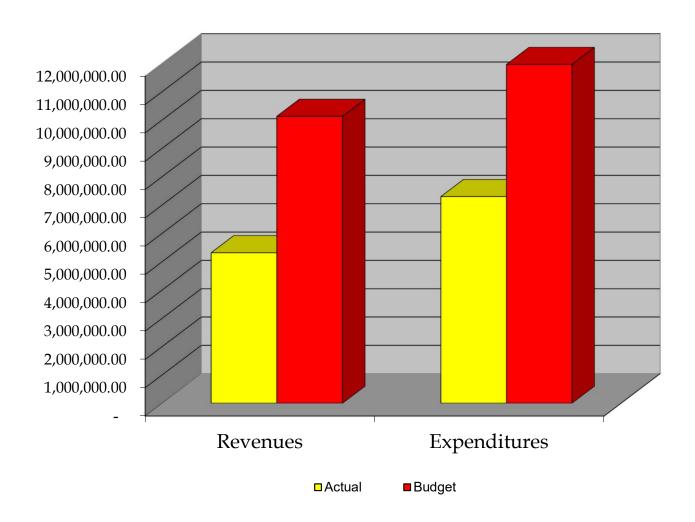


Expenditure - Fund Distribution

For the 9 Month(s) Ending November 30, 2025



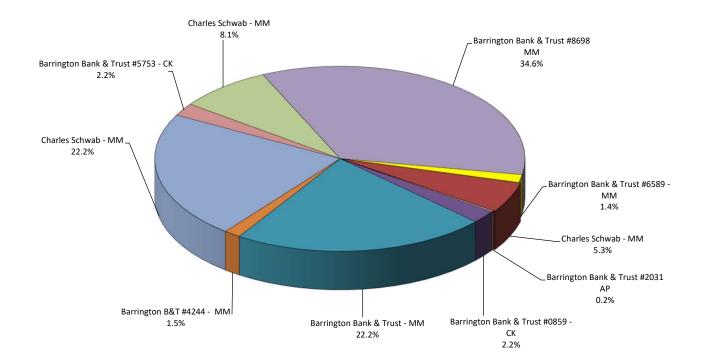

ORDINANCE NO.2025-2026 #04

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF TAXES FOR THE GENERAL TOWN FUND, GENERAL ASSISTANCE FUND AND MENTAL HEALTH BOARD FUND OF THE TOWN OF SCHAUMBURG FOR THE TAX YEAR 2025, COLLECTABLE IN 2026

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Supervisor and Board of Trustees of the Town of Schaumburg, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1: That the sum of EIGHT MILLION, ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY SEVEN THOUSAND, FIFTY EIGHT DOLLARS (\$8,177,058) are hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the Township as that property is assessed and equalized, in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Schaumburg Township as required by statue or voted by the people in accordance with the law.

Section 2: That should any part of the portion of this Ordinance be declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration and adjudication shall be severable and shall affect only that part or portion only and shall not affect any other parts or provisions hereof.

Section 3: that the Town Clerk be and is hereby directed to file a certified copy of the Ordinance with the County Clerk of Cook County within the time specified by law.

Section 4: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval according to law.

Section 5: That the amount levied for each object and purpose shall be as follows:

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF TAXES FOR THE ROAD AND BRIDGE PURPOSES FOR THE TOWN OF SCHAUMBURG ROAD DISTRICT FOR THE TAX YEAR 2025, COLLECTABLE IN 2026

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Supervisor and Board of Trustees of the Town of Schaumburg, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1: That the sum of ONE MILLION, FIVE HUNDRED FIFTY SEVEN THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED FORTY SEVEN, (\$1,557,347) DOLLARS are hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the Township as that property is assessed and equalized, in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Schaumburg Township Road District as required by statue or voted by the people in accordance with the law.
