AARP-TAX AIDE FREE TAX PREPARATION

AARP Tax-Aide helps low- to moderate-income taxpayers file their state and federal tax returns for free. Appointments will be available from February through early April and will be scheduled on a first-come, first-served, first-available basis. To help as many people as possible, taxpayers must have all their tax documents collected before scheduling an appointment. The Tax-Aide Appointment Line will be open Monday - Friday from 9 - 4 pm, beginning January 21. Please call 847-285-4597 to schedule an appointment. Due to the large number of calls for this popular program all appointments must be made through this call line. Walk-ins will be redirected to call the appointment line, and no wait lists will be created. Residents who miss their appointment without canceling at least 24 hours prior will be unable to schedule another appointment without approval from the site coordinator. Appointment availability and a list of required documents will be provided in each edition throughout all of tax season.







SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (SNAP)

The SNAP program provides eligible households with a monthly benefit to supplement their grocery budgets to be able to purchase adequate, healthy food. The monthly SNAP benefit is determined based off a household’s gross monthly income, housing expenses, and medical expenses. Each month, the SNAP benefits will be added to a LINK card that could be used to pay for food at most grocery stores. Gross monthly income criteria for households with someone 60+ or on disability:

1-person household	\$2,608
2-person household	\$3,525
3-person household	\$4,441

REGISTER TO VOTE ONLINE OR AT SCHAUMBURG TOWNSHIP

Cook County voters can register to vote and find information on upcoming elections, early voting locations, polling places and more at cookcountyclerk.gov/elections. Residents can also register in-person at the Schaumburg Township Clerk's Office. The next election in Cook County is March 17.

Beginning with the 2026 primaries, VOTE411.org will replace the Illinois Voter Guide (<https://illinoisvoterguide.org>) as a "one-stop-shop" for election related information. In addition to voter registration and election information, VOTE411.org offers one place for voters to research the candidates.

SOCIAL SERVICES



ILLINOIS TELECOMMUNICATIONS ACCESS CORPORATION (ITAC)

Schaumburg Township is a selection center for the ITAC amplified phone program which provides free phone equipment to qualified Illinois residents with certified hearing loss. Qualified residents may come to Disability & Senior Services to make a live test call on the phones and select one. There are no age or income requirements. Residents need landline and/or cell phone service, proof of Illinois residency and the application signed by a medical professional. Landline users also have the option to include a caption tablet to accompany the Clarity cordless or corded phone. As an ITAC amplified phone client, you are eligible for renewal of your free amplified phone equipment every three years. LOW INCOME HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (LIHEAP)

The LIHEAP program helps eligible low-income households with their gas and electric bills. The program started on October 1, 2025, and will run until August 15, 2026, or until funds are exhausted. To qualify for LIHEAP, the household's 30-day gross income must be at or below the following income guidelines:

\$3,332	1-person household
\$4,357	2-person household
\$5,382	3-person household
\$6,407	4-person household
\$7,432	5-person household

The following documents are required to apply for LIHEAP:

- Social Security cards for everyone in the household
- Proof of 30-day gross income for everyone in the household
- Most recent gas and electric bills

MEDICARE ADVANTAGE ANNUAL ENROLLMENT PERIOD

From January 1 to March 31 each year, Medicare Advantage plan recipients can change Medicare Advantage plans or switch to traditional Medicare with a standalone prescription drug plan. If you are currently on a Medicare Advantage plan and would like to make a change, please call Disability & Senior Services at 847-285-4541 to schedule an appointment. You would need to provide your Medicare card, a list of your prescriptions with the dosage and frequency, and a list of your doctors.
