





2026 VOTER INFORMATION

Residents can register to vote for upcoming elections at the Township of Schaumburg Clerk’s Office. If you have an Illinois driver’s license or state ID, you can also register online at ova.elections.il.gov.

A recent U.S. Postal Service change will affect vote-by-mail ballots. Mail is now postmarked based on when it is processed at a regional distribution center, not when it is dropped off at a local post office. Because of this change, vote-by-mail ballots placed in the mail on Election Day may not receive a same-day postmark and could go uncounted. Election officials strongly encourage voters to mail their ballot at least one week before Election Day or use an official ballot drop box when available.

FIRST INSTALLMENT PROPERTY TAX BILL DUE IN APRIL

Cook County property taxes are due in April. There are many ways to pay including:

- Online at cookcountytreasurer.com, with a checking or savings account
- At 400 Chase Bank locations in Illinois
- By mail, in enclosed return envelope
- Mortgage escrow (Taxpayers should confirm payment with their mortgage-paying firm.)



NEW: FOOD PANTRY ONLINE ORDERING

The Township Food Pantry is now offering free online ordering. Residents in need can order online and either pick up between 8:30-5pm, Monday-Friday or utilize home delivery if transportation is an issue. Online ordering allows residents to pick the foods best suited for their diet, culture and lifestyle. It is available to Township of Schaumburg residents, and the order form can be found at schaumburgtownship.org/food-pantry-online-order-form. Once a form is submitted, the resident will be contacted within two business days to schedule the pickup or delivery. Residents will always get more options by shopping for free at the pantry. Food pantry appointments can be made by calling 847-285-4503.

SOCIAL SERVICES



BENEFIT ACCESS PROGRAM

The Illinois Department on Aging offers a Benefit Access (BA) program for income-eligible seniors (65+) and individuals with a permanent disability (16+). BA recipients receive a license plate sticker discount and would be eligible for a RTA Ride Free pass. Program income requirements are:

- \$33,562 or less for a single person
- \$44,533 or less for a couple

If you think you qualify for BA and need assistance with the application, please call 847-285-4541 for an appointment. BA applications submitted before April 16, 2026 must use 2024 Federal income tax return and all income documents to apply. Applications submitted April 16, 2026 or later must use 2025 Federal income tax return and all income documents. You can also apply at ilaging.illinois.gov/benefitsaccess.



SENIOR HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM (SHIP)

SHIP is a free individual counseling service for Medicare beneficiaries and their caregivers. Disability & Senior Services (DSS) staff are available to provide free, unbiased counseling on Medicare benefits including Part A and B, Medicare Advantage plans (Part C), prescription drug plans (Part D), supplements, Medicare Savings Programs, and Extra Help.
