- I. Call to Order/Pledge of Allegiance/Welcome** – President Bob Ogilvie called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. Pledge of Allegiance was recited. No guests in attendance.

- III. Public Comments** – None
- IV. Approval of Minutes**
 - a. Lauren made a motion to approve the minutes of the February 3, 2026 meeting. MaryAnn seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved by roll call vote.
- V. Reports**
 - a. Executive Director’s report was given by Quinette. See attached.

- VII. New Business**
 - a. Amit Thaker gave an update about ReferralGPS activities and progress. Lauren made a motion to add \$15,000 to the ReferralGPS treatment fund. Binoy seconded the motion. Motion was approved by unanimous roll call vote.
 - b. The ReferralGPS contract for FY26-27 will follow the same funding schedule as the other funded agencies. Lauren made a motion for the MHB to stay in contract with ReferralGPS. MaryAnn seconded the motion. Motion was unanimously approved by roll call vote.
 - c. A funding application was received from Inner Peace Psychological Care, requesting \$32,500. Members thought that this organization could be included as a provider with ReferralGPS and would not need direct support from MHB. Lauren made a motion to deny funding to Inner Peace Psychological Care. Megan seconded this motion. Motion was unanimously approved by roll call vote.

VIII. Approval of Monthly Expenses

- a. Warrant for 2/1/26 – 2/27/26 for \$124,105.51. Lauren made a motion to pay the warrant. Binoy seconded the motion. Motion was unanimously approved by roll call vote.
- b. Warrant for 2/28/26-4/3/26 for \$155,570.21. Lauren made a motion to pay the warrant. Joanmarie seconded the motion. Motion was unanimously approved by roll call vote.

IX. Closed Session

- a. President Ogilvie made a motion to go into closed session: Pursuant to Section 2(c)(21) of the Open Meetings Act – “Discussion of minutes of meetings lawfully closed under this Act, whether for purposes of approval by the body of the minutes or semi-annual review of the minutes as mandated by Section 2.06.” Lauren seconded the motion. Motion was approved by unanimous roll call vote at 8:47pm.
- b. Lauren made a motion to return to open session. Joanmarie seconded the motion. Motion was approved by a unanimous roll call vote at 8:50pm
