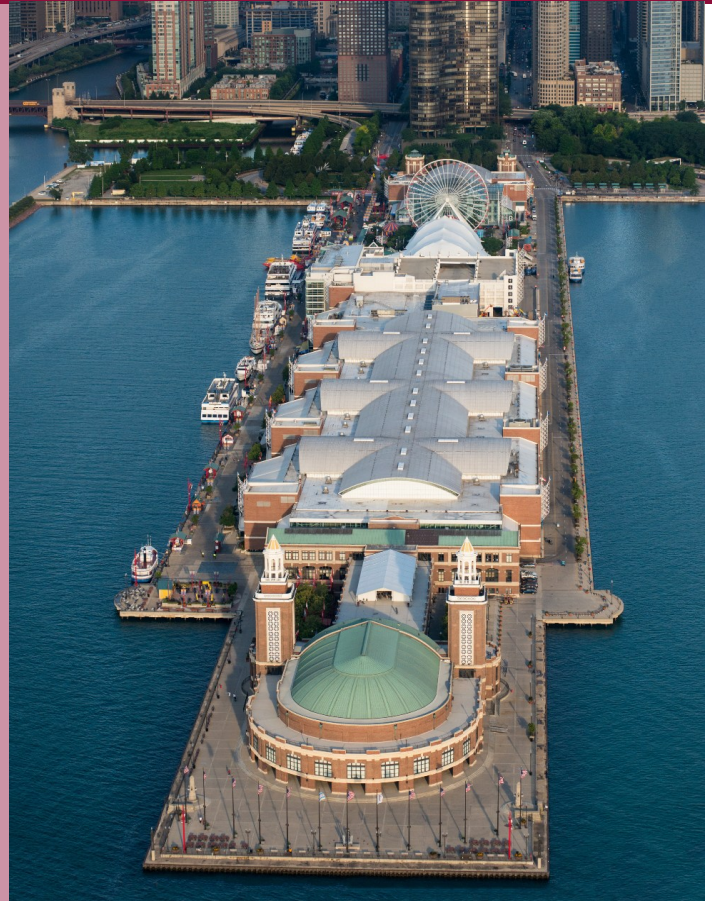

Thank you to our AARP Tax Aide volunteers who assisted with tax preparations for tax year 2025. It was success and the residents appreciated the services provided.

This year the free program helped 880 taxpayers get \$978,057 back in federal and state tax refunds. We also estimate saving taxpayers about \$264,000 in fees, that would have otherwise been spent on return assistance.

MEDICARE SAVINGS PROGRAM

Medicare Savings Programs (MSP) are state programs that assist Medicare users, with limited incomes and assets, pay for Medicare Part A and B premiums and/or cost sharing amounts. You may qualify if:

- You are a single person with a gross monthly income below \$1,819 and assets below \$9,950
- You are a married couple with a gross monthly income below \$2,458 and assets below \$14,910

The Township's Disability and Senior Services Staff are certified SHIP Counselors that can help determine your eligibility and assist with applying. Call 847-285-4541 for more information or an appointment.

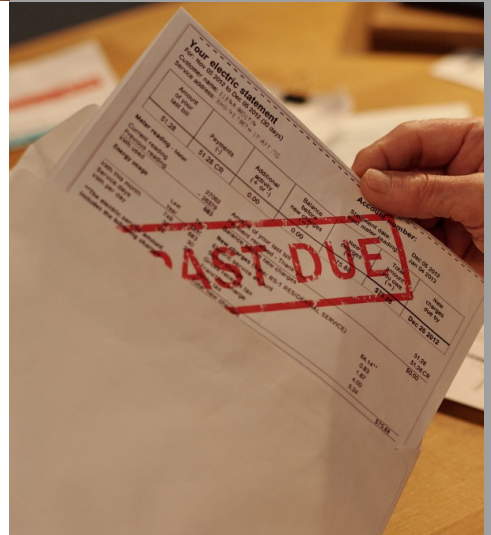

Walk-ups on the day of the event will NOT be accepted. This event is limited to the first 500 guests and will fill quickly, so please register early. Please note:

- The person with the disability must reside in the Village of Schaumburg or the Township of Schaumburg.
- All persons with disabilities must have an able-bodied adult to accompany them on the rides. No exceptions.
- NOT ALL RIDES WILL BE OPEN! The carnival operator is a separate entity and has sole discretion on which rides will be open.

ADA parking will be located at the School District 54 Early Learning Center – enter through the west entrance off Schaumburg Rd. The event is weather-dependent and may be cancelled or delayed. The event will not be rescheduled if cancelled. 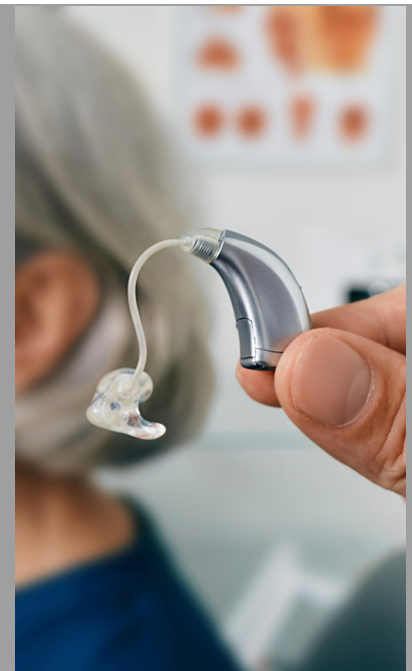
