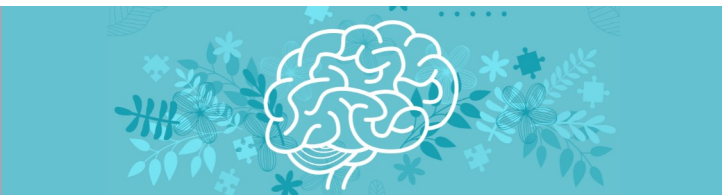

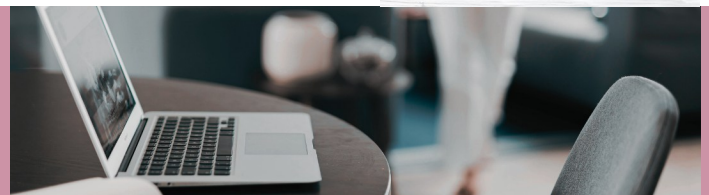

The Township offers free, confidential, counseling sessions with a Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC) on every 4th Monday of the month, from 3 - 7 pm, at 1 Illinois Blvd., Hoffman Estates. Trained in Clinical Mental Health Counseling, the LPC has extensive experience working with adults and couples. If you're struggling with anxiety, depression, relationship issues, grief and loss, trauma, a work or career issue, a life transition or a situation impacting your mental health, he may be able to help. Sometimes all that is needed is a different perspective. No appointment necessary. Must be 18 years+ to participate.



39TH ANNUAL PAINT-A-THON

Paint-A-Thon coordinates volunteers to paint the outside of homes for eligible owners. To qualify, homes must be owned and occupied by adults aged 60 and older, people with disabilities or veterans of any age. There are income and asset limits, but all are encouraged to apply. Seniors aged 65 or older and people with disabilities can receive a discounted fare or ride free permit when using CTA, Metra, or Pace. To apply for the reduced fare permit, residents need to provide a valid government issued ID, proof of disability, and a photo of yourself that is 2 inches square. Illinois residents who are enrolled in the Illinois Department on Aging's Benefit Access program are eligible to ride on the CTA, Metra, and Pace for free. To apply for the ride free permit, residents must provide a valid government issued ID along with a photo that is 2 inches square. RTA applications can be submitted online on fares.rtachicago.org or by appointment in DSS by calling 847-285-4541.

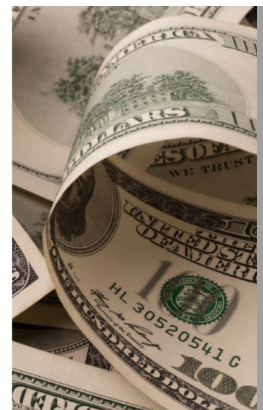
