"Feel My Voice"

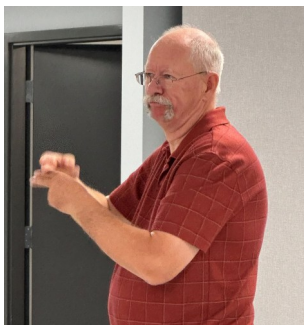

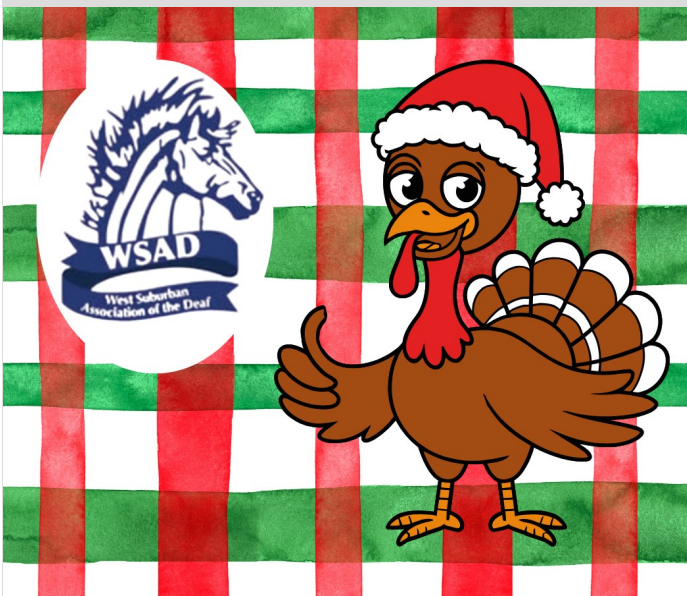
