DISABILITY & SENIOR SERVICES HOLIDAY ADOPTION PROGRAM

DONORS: Make the holiday season a bit brighter by adopting a resident in need. Each donor is provided a wish list of either an individual or a family that includes a senior or person with a disability. If you are interested in adopting an individual or family in need this holiday season, please contact Frances Borja at disabilityservices@schtnw.org by Friday, October 30. Donors will be provided wish lists by Friday, November 13. Donation drop off day is Monday, December 7.

RECIPIENTS: Applications to receive holiday donations will be accepted September 1–October 30. This program is open for seniors aged 55+ and individuals with disabilities who are in need. For families to be eligible, they must include an individual with a disability or grandparent(s) who has custody of grandchildren under the age of 18. Applications must be completed by appointment with a Disability & Senior Services (DSS) staff member either in person or via phone. Applicants will be notified if they are matched with a donor by Friday, November 13. DSS staff does everything possible to match every household with a donor, however, filling out an application does not guarantee adoption. Gifts must be picked up Tuesday, December 8 by the applicant or a proxy designated at application.

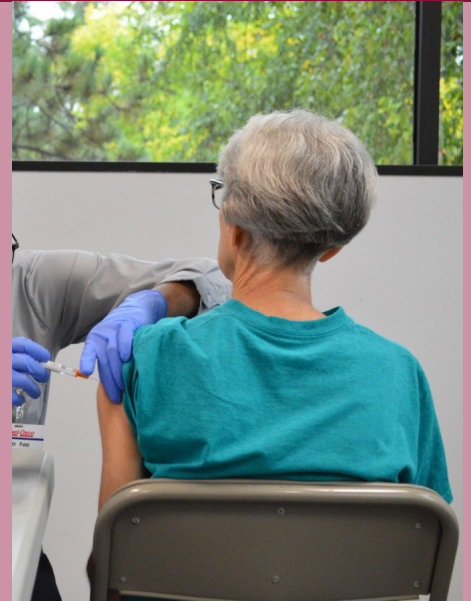

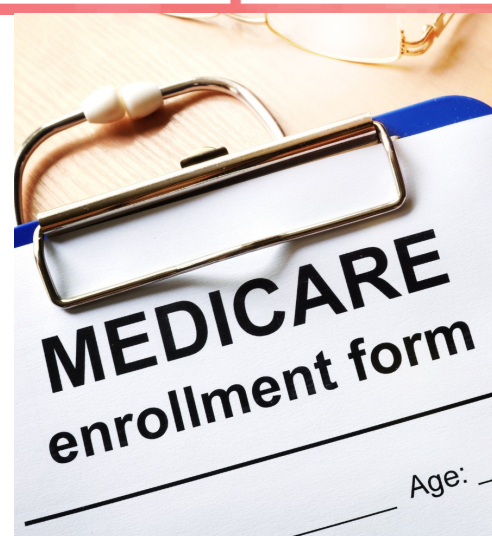

RABIES VACCINE AND MICROCHIP CLINIC

Saturday, September 12 | 10-1pm or until vaccines run out | Costs Vary
Township of Schaumburg

The annual rabies vaccine and microchip clinic will be held September 12, from 10-1pm, or until vaccines run out, at 1 Illinois Blvd, Hoffman Estates. Owners must be Cook County residents and present a valid driver's license or state ID. Dogs and cats must be at least three months old and will be seen on a first-come-first-served basis.

Vaccines and microchips are free however the rabies vaccine tag is \$6 for a 1-year tag and can be ordered at cookcountyil.gov/service/rabies-vaccination-tags. Owners will be given a vaccine certificate for free.

BECOME AN ELECTION JUDGE TODAY!

Election workers are needed for the November 3 general election. Election judges are paid \$250 for the day and are asked to greet voters, sign voters in and ensure smooth polling place operations. MEDICARE OPEN ENROLLMENT: OCTOBER 15 - DECEMBER 7

The Annual Medicare Open Enrollment Period runs from October 15-December 7. During this time, you can make changes to your Medicare Advantage (Part C) and Prescription Drug (Part D) plans for the upcoming year. This is the opportunity to ensure that your plans continue to meet your healthcare and prescription needs. Disability and Senior Services staff are certified Senior Health Insurance Program (SHIP) Counselors that provide free, unbiased Medicare counseling and assistance with enrollment. FAMILIES RECEIVING EMERGENCY SUPPORT FOR HUNGER (FRESH) PROGRAM

The new FRESH program will provide a one-time payment of \$400 to Illinois residents who have already lost SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program) benefits due to expanded federal work requirements. People who have benefits impacted for reasons other than the work requirements will not be eligible for FRESH. If you have questions about FRESH or SNAP, please call to speak with caseworkers from DSS at 847-285-4541.
